Award: These scholarships will be awarded to Johnson County Central High School seniors annually. Each scholarship is a one-time award presented to the senior in the spring of his/her graduating year. Scholarship applications will be dispensed to every senior by the high school counselor. Submitted applications will arrive at the Tecumseh Federal Bank by the deadline date. The scholarship committee at Tecumseh Federal Bank will make the scholarship recipient selections.

Deadline for Application: To be considered for these awards, applications will be presented to Tecumseh Federal Bank by April 1.

Requirements for Application:

- Brief letter of application stating your name, address and telephone number; your desire and financial needs that should be considered for these scholarship awards; what makes you a worthy candidate for consideration.
- Essay discussing
 - your future plans and goals, including college choice(s) and career plans
 - what preparation and experiences you have already accomplished toward completion of your goal(s)
 - a summary of the impact your community involvement has had on you
- Resume' of activities and awards during high school including school, community and work activities

Note: Your letter and essay will not repeat a complete listing of your resume', but will include high points from your resume' that you want to emphasize in your letter or essay.
