The Johnson County School District No. 0050 Board of Education met in special session at 6:40 p.m. on Wednesday, September 9, 2020 in the Middle School Media Center, Cook, Nebraska. The purpose of the meeting was to receive testimony pertinent to the proposed 2020-2021 property tax request. This meeting was advertised in the September 3, 2020 Tecumseh Chieftain as well as at the U.S Post Offices in Cook and Tecumseh Nebraska and the District School Buildings.

Kim Wellensiek called the meeting to order at 6:40 p.m. and stated that a copy of the Open Meetings Law was available for review.

Jon H. Rother, Superintendent, presented information to the Board of Education regarding the proposed property tax request for the 2020-2021 school year as advertised in the September 3, 2020 Tecumseh Chieftain. To meet the proposed 2020-2021 budget, the following taxes are needed: General Fund Tax rate; 0.943308 to generate \$7,042,916.00 and Special Building Fund Tax Rate of 0.053845 to generate, \$402,020.00.
