2016-17 TAX REQUEST RESOLUTION FOR JOHNSON COUNTY CENTRAL PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICT (49-0050)

WHEREAS, public notice was given at least five days in advance of a Special Public Hearing called for the purpose of discussing and approving or modifying the District's Tax Requests for the 2016-17school fiscal year for the General Fund, Bond Fund, and Special Building Fund of Johnson County Central Public School School District (49-0050); and, WHEREAS, such Special Public Hearing was held before the Board of Education (hereinafter "the Board") of Johnson County Central Public School District (49-0050) (hereinafter "the District") at the time, date, and place announced in the notice published in a newspaper of general circulation, a copy of which notice and proof of publication of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A, all as required by law; and,

WHEREAS, the Board provided an opportunity to receive comment, information and evidence from persons in attendance at such Special Hearing; and,

WHEREAS, the Board, after having reviewed the District's Tax Requests for each said fund, and after public consideration of the matter, has determined that the Final Tax Requests as listed below are necessary in order to carry out the functions of the District, as determined by the Board for the 2016-17school fiscal year.

NOW BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that (1) the Tax Request for the General Fund should be, and hereby is set at \$6,332,476.70; (2) the Tax Request for the Bond Fund should be, and hereby is set at \$232,323.23; and (3) the Tax Request for the Special Building Fund should be, and hereby is set at \$216,136.36.

It is so moved by Borcher and seconded by Goracke this 14th day of September, 2016. Roll call vote: Wellensiek-yes, Borcher-yes, Gerdes-yes, Goracke-yes, Gottula-yes, Hunzeker-yes. Carried 6-0.
