Location: Auburn High School – Auburn, NE (1829 Central Ave. – Auburn, NE) **Admission:** Adults - \$6, Students - \$4; Please use exact change if possible.

Conference passes will be accepted.

Buses should drop off players at the southeast door. Buses can park on the west side of the school. We will provide a locker room if requested.

Attendance Information: We are in Phase 4 of the State of Nebraska's DHM (75% capacity) but are still using some Phase 3 directives.

<u>We will be using a pass list for this event</u>. Each participant is allowed <u>six people</u>. Please go to the following link (<u>https://forms.gle/aqtS9haauDjfGjDw7</u>) and follow the directions to submit your pass list.

No individual (player, coach, manager, videographer, stat keeper, spectator, or other) should attend the game if experiencing any of the following:

- Fever of 100.4F or above, chills
- Sudden onset of a cough
- Sudden onset of shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Muscle or body aches
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea

Each school is responsible for temperature checking and symptom screening their athletes, coaches, managers, and bus driver(s) prior to arrival.

Team Masking: Players, coaches, and team personnel should mask when they are not in the gym. Masking by team personnel is optional while in the gym. Masks may be worn by players while competing but they must meet all NFHS / NSAA guidelines. Table help also needs to wearing a mask.

Benches: Johnson County Central will have the bench to the left of the scorer's table as you face it. Auburn will have the bench to the right of the scorer's table as you face it. The teams will not switch benches. Chairs will be spread out more than usual but we will not have six feet of distance in between every chair. Additionally, we will section off some of the south bleachers for each team to use for their team personnel. This area will be marked. Please wear masks on the bench if you are concerned about distancing at the bench area. Per the State of Nebraska's Phase 3 DHM, "players should not share towels, water bottles, or other equipment."

Water: Per the Phase 3 DHM, "Players must bring their own water/beverage to consume during and after practice/games. No shared/communal drinking fountains or coolers." For that reason, please bring your own water/beverages as we do not plan to supply a water cooler at the bench area. There is a water refill station within the drinking fountain just outside of the gym near the restrooms.

Equipment: Please bring your own balls for warm up. We will supply an empty ball cart. We will sanitize game balls periodically throughout the contest.

Pregame / Postgame: Handshakes are prohibited. Fans and players are asked to leave the gym and return to their vehicles as quickly as possible after the game.

Cheerleaders: Auburn will be limited to six cheerleaders. Because of space limitations, we would ask that you bring no more than four cheerleaders. Cheerleaders are asked to either be on the baseline or if they go out in front of the crowd that they remain more toward the middle of the floor to allow for plenty of distancing.

Pep Bands: No pep bands are allowed for this event.

Spectators: <u>All visiting spectators must be on the entry / pass list prior to the event. All spectators will need to be temperature checked at the gate so please arrive early. Spectators are strongly encouraged to wear masks and asked to socially distance.</u>

<u>Auburn fans will enter the north door and sit in the north bleachers and visiting fans should enter the southeast door and sit in the south bleachers</u>. Spectators should avoid intermingling with fans from the other school.

All children 5th Grade and younger must sit with their parents and be supervised at all times.

Concessions: Regular concession stand food items will be offered. All fans are encouraged to wear masks and practice social distancing while waiting in line.
