- 1. Race times and awards ceremony:
 - a. 4:00 p.m. Girls 5k Race
 - b. 4:45 p.m. Boys 5k Race
 - c. 5:30 p.m. Awards near start line (different place than on the map)
- 2. Teams Competing: David City Aquinas Catholic, Fremont Archbishop Bergan, Centennial, College View Academy, Bellevue Cornerstone Christian, Deshler, East Butler, Fillmore Central, Freeman, Johnson County Central, McCool Junction, Omaha Christian Academy, Palmyra, Pawnee City, Thayer Central, Tri County, Yutan

3. PARKING

- a. All fans should enter Camp Kateri through the Parking Zones 1, 2, and 3 Entrance and Exit shown on the map if they plan on arriving before the meet and staying for the duration. If fans plan on leaving the meet early, it may be best for them to park along the gravel road in Parking Zone 4. Please park far enough over so through traffic can traverse the roadway. There will be parking attendants to direct those entering the camp who are not parking on the gravel road.
- b. Please notice on the maps that Parking Zones 1, 2, and 3 Entrance/Exit is also a part of the course. This entrance leads to the Entire Meet Parking lot. People who park in this area will need to arrive before the girls race by 3:50. Nobody will be allowed in and out of those parking lots from 3:50 until the conclusion of the races.
- c. If you arrive before 3:50, and know you have to leave early, you can park on Road 4, the gravel road north of Camp Kateri, that is Parking Zone 4 on the map.
- 4. To limit possible COVID 19 spread, in lieu of packets being handed out to fans upon arrival at Camp Kateri, QR code stations will be posted throughout Camp Kateri that will have pertinent meet day information for meet attendees. This QR code will provide access to fan maps, meet information, top course performances, and course records. People in attendance that have an app on their phone or handheld device that can read these QR codes will have access to this meet information. Any part of the course is fair game for viewing. Please just stay clear of meet workers and runners competing. If a trail is flagged off, that trail is flagged off so runners do not take a wrong trail. However, spectators can feel free to navigate those trails to watch each race.
- 5. The map includes course markings every 400 meters and also every 1000 meters so viewers can have an idea of where runners are at in a race. All of these locations identified on the map also have a t-post with a banner, indicating those distances on the course itself.
- 6. Please note where the bathrooms are located on your map. There is a unisex bathroom on the east side of the bathroom building and male and female bathrooms with multiple stalls on the west side of the bathroom building. Within each bathroom will be hand pump sprayers filled with hand sanitizer for sterilizing any bathroom items before or after use, should you choose to do so. We also plan on having porta-potties at the meet for bathroom usage.
- 7. At the conclusion of the meet we will have an awards ceremony near the start line. We understand that this is the district meet and is only one week away from the state meet. While we want to protect everyone as much as we can from any possible COVID 19 spread, we still plan on having a socially distanced award ceremony to honor those qualifying for the

state meet. This will take place near the start line. Anyone in attendance of this awards ceremony WILL be expected to wear a mask. We will call up individuals to receive their district medals and will space them out 6 feet apart after receiving their medals. We will then have a photographer take a picture of all award winners. These photographs will be posted on the @mccoolmustangxc twitter account and will also be emailed out to all coaches who can then disperse them to fans and athletes. Team standings will also be announced and a photo opportunity will be available for teams that qualified for state on the awards platform. All medals and awards will be announced over the public address system near the finish line so those in attendance can hear those results. Once again, we just ask that all fans stay back
