### Winter Sports Attendance Plans

#### Updated 12/31/20 (Current Guidelines/DHM)

**This is the current plan for hosting basketball games at Mead Public Schools. We feel this is an appropriate plan based on current information. PLEASE NOTE: These plans may be altered at any time due to updated information or changing circumstances. We appreciate your cooperation as we try to provide an environment that will allow our athletes to complete their athletic seasons.**

- All spectators will be required to wear a mask upon entering the building.
- Coaches and event staff, with the possible exception of game officials, will be required to wear a mask.
- Households should sit together and maintain 6-feet of space between other households when possible.
- Games will be available via livestream.

- Home and Visitor sides have been swapped from previous years.
- Additional space will be marked off around team benches, behind the scorer's table, and the front row.
- The stage will be reserved for
  - Overflow for the visiting fan base from their section.
  - Participating student-athletes.
  - The stage will not be available during JH games.
- Admission payments in exact amounts are preferred to eliminate the need to provide change.
- To adhere to current DHM's, a ticketing system will be used to allow spectators entry to the events
  - DHM at 75% Capacity
    - HS Basketball: each school will receive an allotment of 200 tickets
  - DHM at 50% Capacity
    - HS Basketball: each school will receive an allotment of 150 tickets.
    - JH Basketball: each school will receive an allotment of 100 tickets.
  - DHM at 25% Capacity: Spectators limited to Household Members/Grandparents of Players
    - HS Basketball: each school will receive an allotment of 75 tickets.
    - JH Basketball: each school will receive an allotment of 50 tickets.
  - ADMISSION WITHOUT A TICKET WILL NOT BE ALLOWED.
- Concessions items will be limited.
- Students and children will be expected to remain seated as much as possible. Repeated trips to the Commons for concessions will be discouraged.
- Tables in the Commons will be unavailable to spectators.
- Bands are not allowed.
- Cheerleaders are limited to 8 per school, and must be masked.
- Players will proceed directly to locker rooms or designated areas after games are completed.
- Spectators will leave upon the completion of the games.
